SACC Webinars

Hosting a webinar is an effective way to introduce your organization to a large group of SACC candidates in a virtual setting. Here are some tips to help make your webinar a success –

1. Use the email list in the candidate report to invite candidates to attend your webinar.
2. Make sure you have Zoom on your computer / iPad.
3. Identify a speaker(s). You can have an individual speaker, a duo or even a panel - whatever works best to present your message.
4. We find it helpful to have a representative from your team available to answer / field candidate questions during the webinar. If that's not an option, a member of the SACC team can assist.
5. The speaker(s) can share their screen to present slides, photos or videos.
6. If you'd like to do a practice webinar or walk thru, let me know. We can set up a test for you.

Prior to Virtual SACC –

Please provide this information as soon as possible but no later than 22 October.

1. Please send a photo and short bio of your speaker(s). This will be added to our website.
2. Please provide names and email addresses of all panelists/speakers. This is needed to invite them to the Zoom.

Day of Webinar –

1. Webinars will be open 15 minutes prior to start time. This will give your team time to assemble, check mics, lighting, etc....
2. A member of the SACC team will make introductions and share instructions with candidates. We will remain in the webinar for technical support and to assist with candidate questions if needed.
3. Webinars are recorded and stored on the private SACC YouTube Channel. We then send links to all candidates – so folks unable to attend live can watch prior to Friday's event.
